

Microsoft 365 Introduction to PowerBI

Overview

PowerBI Desktop is part of the suite of tools from Microsoft which enable data to be analysed and published from a variety of sources.

With PowerBI Desktop, you get a report authoring tool that enables you to connect and query data from different sources using the Query Editor. From the datasets you build with Query Editor you can add visualisations and create reports. Reports can then be published.

Audience

The course introduces PowerBI Desktop and is designed for users who are looking to make a bigger impact with the way in which they want to report on data through visualisations.

It covers the use of PowerBI Desktop to connect to data, create visualisations, query the data and publish reports.

Please note that this course does not cover PowerBI Pro, PowerBI accessed via Microsoft 365 or SharePoint Services.

- Use data sources that are compatible with PowerBI Desktop.
- Connect to data.
- Explore data visualisations.
- Apply common query tasks to shape data in PowerBI Desktop.

This course is not suitable for users who are new to Excel or Databases as delegates must have an understanding of the basic data concepts.

Delegates must already have the knowledge and ability to create and format chart outputs and they should also have a basic understanding of Functions (ideally Aggregate Functions).
