#### What is an NVQ?

An NVQ is a National Vocational Qualification which is Recognised in the Construction Industry.

#### Why do I need an NVQ?

You need an NVQ to prove you are competent in the job you do. It is fast becoming a requirement on site for all operatives to be qualified and to hold a CSCS card.

#### What do I have to do?

You will register for your NVQ and be profiled and inducted by your assessor in the first visit, you will need to complete 5 or 6 different units on site with your assessor over an agreed period of time and gather evidence. If you wish to apply for a CSCS card you will also need to pass a Health & Safety test. Your assessor can give you details on how to book this.

The units for your qualification are:-

**QCF641:- Conforming to General Health, Safety and Welfare in the Workplace**

**QCF642:- Conforming to Productive Working Practices in the Workplace**

**QCF643:- Moving, Handling and Storing Resources in the Workplace**

**QCF72:- Positioning and Securing Fibrous Plaster Components in the Workplace**

**QCF73:- Repairing Fibrous Plaster Components in the Workplace**

**And for the Full Route:**

**QCF74:- Producing Fibrous Plaster Components in the Workplace**

The sort of evidence you will need to start collecting are copies of time sheets or invoices, copies of site rules, any inductions you have received on site, site drawings marking where you have worked, tool box talks you have attended, delivery notes you may have signed.
