Group Size:
Maximum 8 learners x 1 Instructor **or** Maximum 12 learners x 2 Instructors.

Who Should Attend?

All persons who will be required by their employer to work on motorways and high speed dual carriageways in the position of Traffic Management Foreman. All persons who require completing this programme as part of their achievement to become a Traffic Safety Control officer (TSCO)

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of the course the learners must be able to: -

- Work out the traffic management layout required to facilitate access to a given work area
- Work out the distances required for a range of traffic management layouts
- Calculate the amount of equipment required for a given traffic management layout.
- Assess the standard of equipment that is acceptable to use
- Understand the planning required for Standard Works
- Understand the different types of temporary markings that are used
- Understand how different Standard Works are constructed
- Understand how temporary lane closures can be used in conjunction with Standard Works

Certification:

On completion, all learners will be required to undertake a written examination which carries a 75% pass mark. Lantra Awards will issue a certificate to successful learners. To operate as a Foreman you **MUST** complete the operative's course, complete all assessments in the Logbook and attend the Foreman course before a skills registration card can be issued by Lantra Awards.

NB:

Learners who score 70-74% will be permitted to re-sit the paper not less than 2 weeks and no more than 8 weeks after the initial test date. Only one re-sit will be permitted. If a learner is again unsuccessful they must re-sit the whole course before taking the test again. Learners scoring less than 70% must re-sit the whole course before re-sitting the end of course test.
