

Course objective

Develop knowledge and practical skills in the construction of **CasoLine MF** ceilings.

Course content

- The importance of Health and Safety including safe systems of work and risk assessments
- Understand the differences between lay in grid ceiling systems and CasoLine MF ceiling systems
- Understand the methods of suspension and reasons for fixing methods for metal furring sections to the primary grid sections
- Understand drawing plans prior to setting out and installing the ceiling system
- Construct the ceiling system forming flat ceilings and return bulkheads
- Form access hatches using CasoLine MF ceiling components
- Installation of pre-fabricated access panels
- Understand the principles of boarding for single and double layer boarding
- Develop an understanding regarding the range and size of Gyproc plasterboards used on CasoLine MF ceiling systems
- Understand the range of sound absorbent Gyptone and Rigitone boards used with the **CasoLine mF** ceiling systems
- Understand the range of tools required to build CasoLine MF ceiling systems
